

Premarital Packet Instructions

Directions: Prior to our initial meeting I will need you to take some time to complete the following. This information will help me get to know you and make our time together more productive.

- [1] **Biographical data sheets.** The groom should answer the questions on the blue sheet and the bride on the pink sheet. Be sure your answers are legible. You may continue your answers on the back if needed.
- [2] **Premarital Covenant.** Each of you should read through the covenant and sign it indicating your agreement. Call me if you have any questions or concerns regarding the covenant.
- [3] **Taylor-Johnson Temperament Analysis Test.** You should received two test booklets and four answer sheets. This will allow each of you to take the test twice. The first time you will answer the questions as they apply to you. The second time you will answer the questions as they apply to your fiancé. Make sure you indicate on the answer sheet to whom the answers apply and by whom the answers are given. This is very important. Each test will take about 30 minutes or so. Please read the instructions on the booklet before you begin. Upon completion of the tests return the answer sheets and your test booklets to my secretary with the other completed materials listed above. Please note, if you mail these materials it is advised that you make a copy of your T-JTA answer sheets in case the originals are lost in the mail.

A few other comments regarding taking the test:

- answer the questions as fairly and objectively as you can.
- do not leave any questions blank
- take the test at a time when you can complete it without interruption or distractions.
- do not compare your answers with your fiancé.

There is no charge to take the T-JTA test. The results of the test will help me get to know you individually and as a couple. Almost without exception I have found that couples find this to be a very helpful part of the counseling.
