Class Objectives

T = Teaching

- Consistent with Chapel Doctrinal Statement.
- Sound, biblical content with relevant application.
- Mix of monologue / dialogue with a variety of styles.
- Avoid divisiveness and “hobby horses.”
- Keep ABF Director informed of teachers / topics.

A = Assimilation

- Keep attendance and Class Roster.
- Contact absentees in gracious manner.
- Introduce new people in a non-threatening way.
- Follow up visitors with a call or card.
- Encourage involvement in ministry that matches their gifts and interests.

S = Supplication

- Keep one another informed of prayer needs and praises.
- Notify church of prayer needs for church prayer list.
- Take time to pray as a part of gathering together (be creative).
- Encourage intercession during the week.

K = Koinonia

- Schedule gatherings to get to know each other and build relationships.
- Include periodic testimonies (salvation and spiritual growth).
- Schedule outreach events to build bridges to unsaved / un-churched.
- Encourage accountability (don't force it).
