

Apprentice Program Use of Funds Raised

This agreement between The Chapel on the Campus, Inc. and the below named participant in The Chapel's Apprentice Program is to detail how funds raised in the program are to be utilized.

Ownership of Funds Raised

It is agreed that the funds raised belong to The Chapel on the Campus, Inc. and are to be used to fund all or part of the salary and associated expenses of the below named Apprentice during their employment for The Chapel. Once deposited in a Chapel owned bank account, the funds are no longer under the control of the Apprentice or any other party other than duly authorized representatives of The Chapel.

Funding Shortfall

If, at any time, the funds on hand that have been raised by the Apprentice are not sufficient to cover their portion of their salary, The Chapel may suspend the employment of the Apprentice until such a time as sufficient funds have been raised.

Funds Remaining After Employment Ends

If, upon leaving the employ of The Chapel, an Apprentice has funds remaining in his or her apprentice account, the funds will remain at The Chapel and will be used for other Chapel ministry opportunities as approved by the Chapel's Management Team or Board of Elders. When raising funds, the Apprentice should let potential donors know the following: In the unlikely event the Apprentice raises more funds than are necessary for their support and expenses under The Chapel's Apprentice Program, any excess funds will be used by The Chapel for similar programs or for other ministry opportunities.

An Apprentice who has been accepted into a ministry training program approved by the Chapel Management Team or Board of Elders can request to utilize any remaining funds toward his/her seminary training. Such requests should be made prior to leaving the Chapel's Apprentice Program.
