

Solicitation Policy

Any person in need of food, shelter or financial support for any reason should contact an elder or staff member to present the request for consideration of special needs. Such request shall not be made to any other person while on the premises of The Chapel, including any and all buildings, and all of the physical property owned or leased by The Chapel. This policy does not prohibit children from pursuing fund-raising activities such as the sale of Girl Scout cookies or fund-raising for missions trips.
